The Warrior Legion baseball team “hit” the big time in 2009 under the team’s Senior leadership, superior coaching, and help from a generous alum.

The team, fueled by a disappointing 2008 post season, cruised through the regular season until meeting their nemesis, Prep, in the State Finals. The Junior Jays crushed the Warriors just a month earlier in regular season play but couldn’t overcome a stellar performance by the Warriors in their season finale.

The Warrior Legion team, KB Building Services, sponsored by Alum D.J. Rezac (‘89), had a successful summer, which again led to a matchup in the Division final against Prep. Warrior wins against Prep and Millard West resulted in a Nebraska Class A Legion Championship, and a trip to Minneapolis to play in a National tournament.

TEAM FROM 2004 CLAIMS ALUMNI BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP

The Alumni Basketball tournament was held on Saturday Nov. 28, 2009, and the GOOD news is that we had over 1000 alums come and play, resulting in contributions of \$10,000. The BAD news is that about 950 of these alums were imaginary and forgot to contribute. Darn!

OK, we actually had 51 players, who formed 7 teams, which has held steady for the last few years. We also had a number of parents and friends stop by to cheer us on. It was great to see players from '03, '04, '05, '07, and '09 all entered; the participation and retention of newer and younger alumni is adding to the success of the Annual Alumni Basketball tournament. After all, Ted Bridges '76, Jason Hellman '90, and Tom Thompson '83 can only carry the OLD alumni team so far. More good news, no players from the OLD team died nor were seriously injured, despite their advanced age. In the 2009 Championship Game, Team 2004 defeated Team 2003. Each of those teams has now won the Tournament a couple of times. Of course, the all time champs continue to be Class of 1990, led by none other than Hellman.

There was a VIP appearance at this year's tournament by NU freshman, quarterback Cody Green - who joined the family of Annie Wilkinson '09, who played as the only female in the tournament. Annie scored 6 points AND snatched a critical steal against Tom Thompson in the game against the old folks, to nearly seal the win for the '09 class.

Still more good news, the event continues to raise enough money to fund the Tom Hall Scholarship for a graduating varsity basketball player to use in his first year at college. A companion scholarship, the Vic Porter Scholarship, is also annually awarded to a female varsity player. In addition to the Basketball Tourney, there is also an Alumni Soccer event (second year - held the day after Thanksgiving), an Alumni Baseball event (now in its fourth year - held the Saturday before Memorial day in May), and a cross country Fun Run (in the fall, now in its third year). A swimming event is also in the planning stages.
