Westside swimming has been synonymous with excellence for decades. Between the 37 state team titles, 171 individual state titles and nearly 200 Academic and Athletic All-Americans, our history exemplifies a longstanding dedication to developing successful student athletes. The pool and natatorium that fostered this culture have been overlooked for decades and have largely remained unchanged since construction in the early 1960s. With our planned renovations, student athletes will be able to continue Westside's longstanding tradition of excellence in swimming and diving.

Celebrating Two Legacies

Westside was incredibly fortunate to have two legendary coaches paving the way for our program. Coaches Cal Bentz and Doug Krecklow mentored and championed hundreds of athletes over the years. In order to name the new pool and natatorium in honor of these coaches, we must raise \$3 million to meet the District's naming policy guidelines. Continue Westside's Legacy as the Pinnacle of High School Swimming & Diving

One of the highlights of this project is the installation of a Myrtha pool. This type of pool has been used in the last several Olympic Games, as well as in Paris in 2024. Myrtha pools are designed to limit maintenance and upkeep costs, and allow swimmers to achieve faster times due to the pool's unique technology. The new Myrtha pool will help maintain Westside's position as the leader of high school athletics.
