

Construction Update October

Through the month of October & early November the building structure has started to take shape. The east and south foundation walls were completed to the extents required for structural install. A portion of the south wall will remain open to allow material and equipment access for pool installation. Structural steel erection continued with the completion of NE Stair Tower, East Level 1 (locker rooms & classrooms), East Level 2 (training & therapy), and East Level 3 (pool seating and concourse). Construction of the pool structure began with completion of the west pool wall and surge tank walls. The first slab pour took place on 11/11 infilling the old pool. This slab will be the future fitness center/wrestling room.
















11/11/2024 Level 1 West Slab Pour
